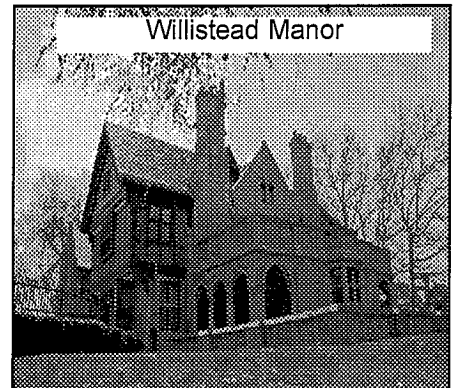
## Attractions Include:

**John Freeman Walls Historic Site** - The Windsor area was a terminal of the famous "Underground Railroad", the first great freedom movement in America. The movement was started in Columbia, PA in 1804 by a Quaker abolitionist. He used railroad terminology to confuse the slave catchers. A person leading the fugitives to freedom would be known as *Conductor*. It would be their responsibility to get *Passengers* (fugitives), from one *Station* (safehouse) to another until they would eventually reach a *Terminal* in northern U.S. or Canada, where there was freedom. Enjoy a comprehensive tour of this remarkable landmark.

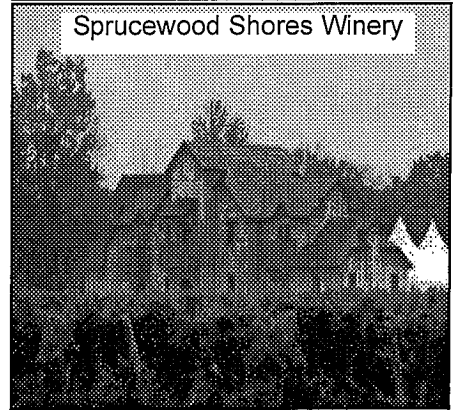
**Willistead Manor** - is a 36-room mansion built by Edward Walker, son of whisky baron Hiram Walker, in 1917. The manor's Tudor-Jacobean architecture reflects 20th century ingenuity and the elegance of another era. A tour of the mansion highlights our visit.

**Sprucewood Shores Winery** - Located on a 52-acre farm on the beautiful shores of Lake Erie, Sprucewood Shores Estate Winery is the dream of a local family and the most hospitable and unique of the area's 12 wineries.

**Lunch @ Caldwell's Grant** - Amherstburg, Ontario has one of Windsor/Essex County's best restaurants. The building was built in 1836 and today offers a casual fine dining experience.
