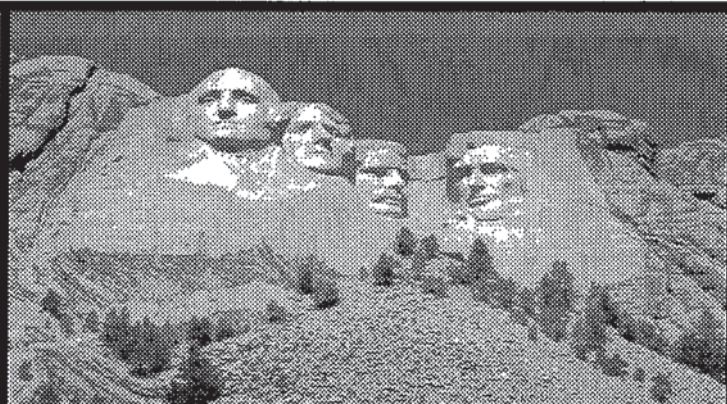

Sample Itinerary:

Day 1 - Fly non-stop Detroit to Denver and begin a remarkable vacation. We'll stay in **downtown Denver**. **Dinner at your leisure downtown.**

Day 2 - Breakfast included. Travel through **Colorado National Monument** and witness one of the grand landscapes of the American West. Towering monoliths exist within a vast plateau - and - canyon panorama. Experience sheer-walled, red rock canyons along the scenic twists and turns of Rim Rock Drive. Later this afternoon arrive in **Moab, Utah** at the beautiful **Red Cliffs Lodge** for **(2) nights**. Nestled on the banks of the Colorado River, surrounded by magnificent 2000 feet high cliffs, the Red Cliffs Lodge is truly a hidden treasure of the west. Inside, the lodge features dramatic 20-foot ceiling, natural wood paneled walls, rustic log furniture and hand finished Mexican tile floors. Check it out at www.redcliffslodge.com. A **Cowboy Grill BBQ dinner is included** overlooking the towering red rock cliffs that surround the lodge.

Day 3 - Breakfast included. **Arches National Park** preserves over 2,000 natural sandstone arches, like the world-famous Delicate Arch, as well as many other unusual rock formations. In some areas the forces of nature have exposed millions of years of geologic history. A **sightseeing tour** highlights the extraordinary features of the park that create a landscape of contrasting colors, landforms and textures that is unlike anything else on earth. **Canyonlands National Park** has been described as **"The Most Magical Place on Earth"**. It preserves a bizarre and colorful landscape eroded into countless mesas and deep river gorges by the Colorado River. Stunning sightseeing of the park highlights our afternoon. **Dinner again included** at our lodge.

Day 4 - Breakfast included. Travel to **Salt Lake City, Utah** for our next night. An afternoon **sightseeing tour is included** as well as an **included dinner**.

Day 5 - Breakfast included. Continuing north we'll skirt the shores of Great Salt Lake and view dramatic Logan Canyon. Arrive mid-afternoon in **Jackson Hole, Wyoming**, a valley encompassed by the mountain ranges of the Grand Tetons. Spend the afternoon at your leisure enjoying the lovely town of Jackson Hole. Jackson Hole is an all-western town with wooden sidewalks, swing door salons and western shops. Visit the unique specialty boutiques and upscale galleries that dot the town. Of course, all of this while surrounded by the majestic Grand Tetons. **Overnight** right in downtown Jackson Hole at **The 49er Inn & Suites**.

Day 6 - Breakfast included. **Grand Teton National Park's** majestic mountains are among the most magnificent mountain ranges in the world. The **Teton Range** is the most impressive with its abrupt vertical rise to 13,000 feet. Enjoy a leisurely **boat cruise on Jackson Lake** followed by an **included lunch at Jackson Lake Lodge** with a panoramic view of the **Grand Tetons**. Later travel to **West Yellowstone** for a **(2) night stay at the Clubhouse Inn**, a charming hotel located just outside Yellowstone National Park.

Day 7 - Breakfast included. Certainly, there are many unique and wonderful places on the earth. But perhaps none quite as unique as the world's first national park, **Yellowstone National Park**. The area is filled with Nature's wonders: thick forest, towering mountains of granite, sparkling lakes, massive waterfalls, thousands of hot springs, and of course **Old Faithful**, the most recognizable feature in the Park. An **all day sightseeing tour** takes us through the wonders of **Yellowstone National Park** including **the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone**. **Dinner included** at our lodge.

Day 8 - Breakfast included. Visit the **Buffalo Bill Historical Center** in Cody, WY and learn about the life of Buffalo Bill Cody, the noted guide, scout, showman, actor, town founder and American icon. **Overnight in Gillette, WY.**

Day 9 - Breakfast included. Two of America's iconic monuments highlight our day. **Crazy Horse Memorial** will eventually be the world's largest mountain sculpture. The carving of the legendary Lakota leader Crazy Horse is nothing short of amazing!!! **Mount Rushmore National Memorial** represents the first 130 years of the history of The United States and is America's most recognized memorial. Overnight in **Deadwood, SD**, a National Historic Landmark. A wild west town that was once ruled by outlaws and gun-slingers is now a lively gaming town with dozens of unique western-style gaming parlors.

Day 10 - Breakfast included then continue back to Denver for our last night. **Dinner included**

Day 11 - Fly home to Detroit non-stop.
